You also carry out legal research, draft notices and pleadings, deliver oral or written submissions. You provide legal advice to and obtain instructions from the AJC Representations Committee and Exclusions Committee. You may also be called upon to provide advice and labour relations support to members and the Executive or Governing Council from time to time. You review Treasury Board and other employer policies, directives and processes. You attend employer-related meetings as the need arises.
